*Using an Out-of-Network Dentist

Out-of-network dentists may charge more than Aetna's recognized amount. Preventive care is covered at the usual and customary rate, which may be less than 100% of the dentist's fee. Employees are responsible for any remaining balance and may need to pay upfront and submit a claim to Aetna.

Before receiving extensive or costly treatment, ask the dentist to submit a predetermination of benefits. This provides an estimate of the plan payment and employee responsibility but does not guarantee coverage or payment.
